

The Wardrobe Game

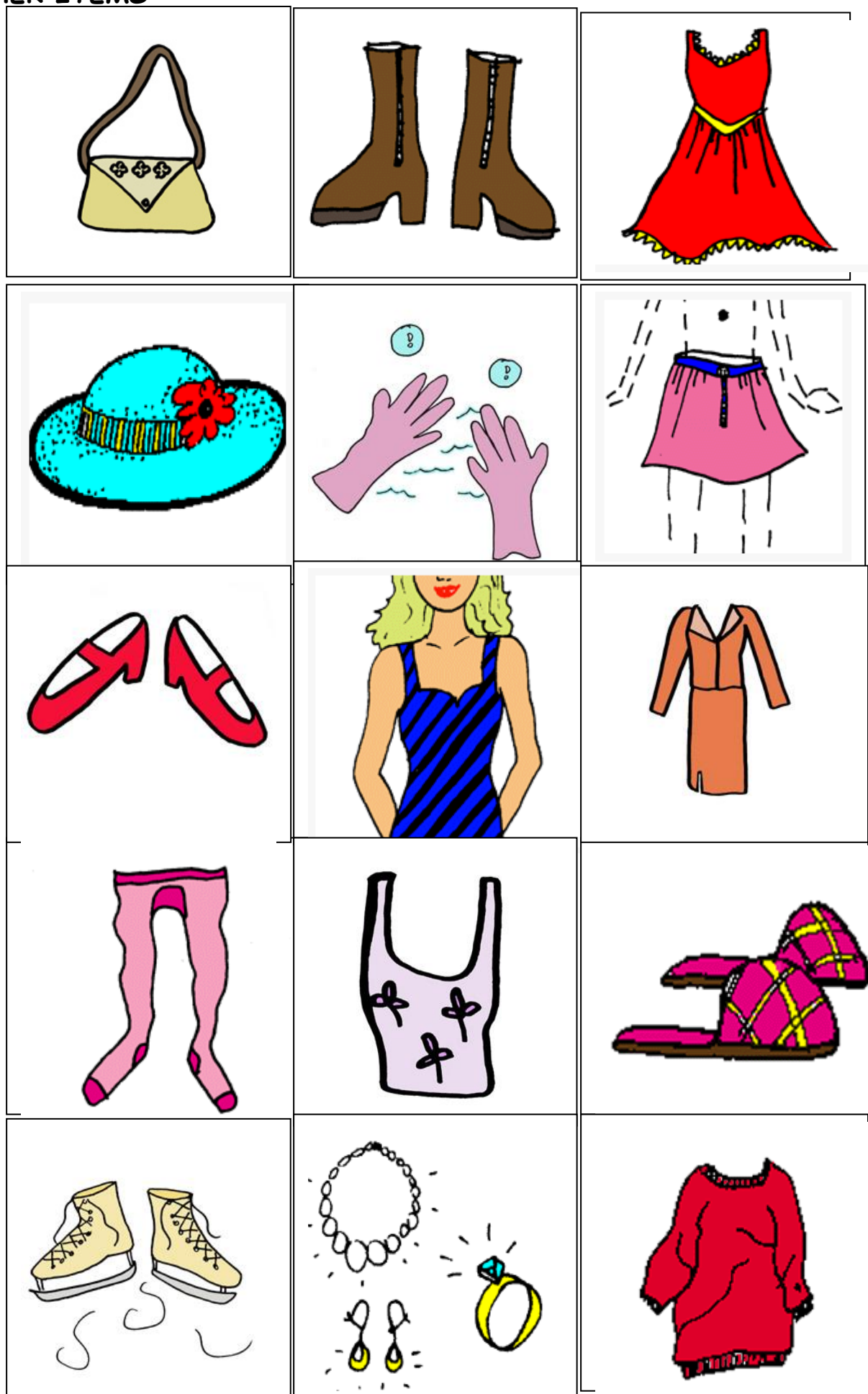
No. of Players:	2+
Object of Game:	To pack the boy or girls clothes into the correct wardrobe.
You need:	Boy and girl items A boy and girl wardrobe (Cut along dotted lines to create a posting slot in the wardrobe) OR simply cover the wardrobe with the items.

AIM: For the student to correctly use **her/his** in a sentence describing the child's clothing.

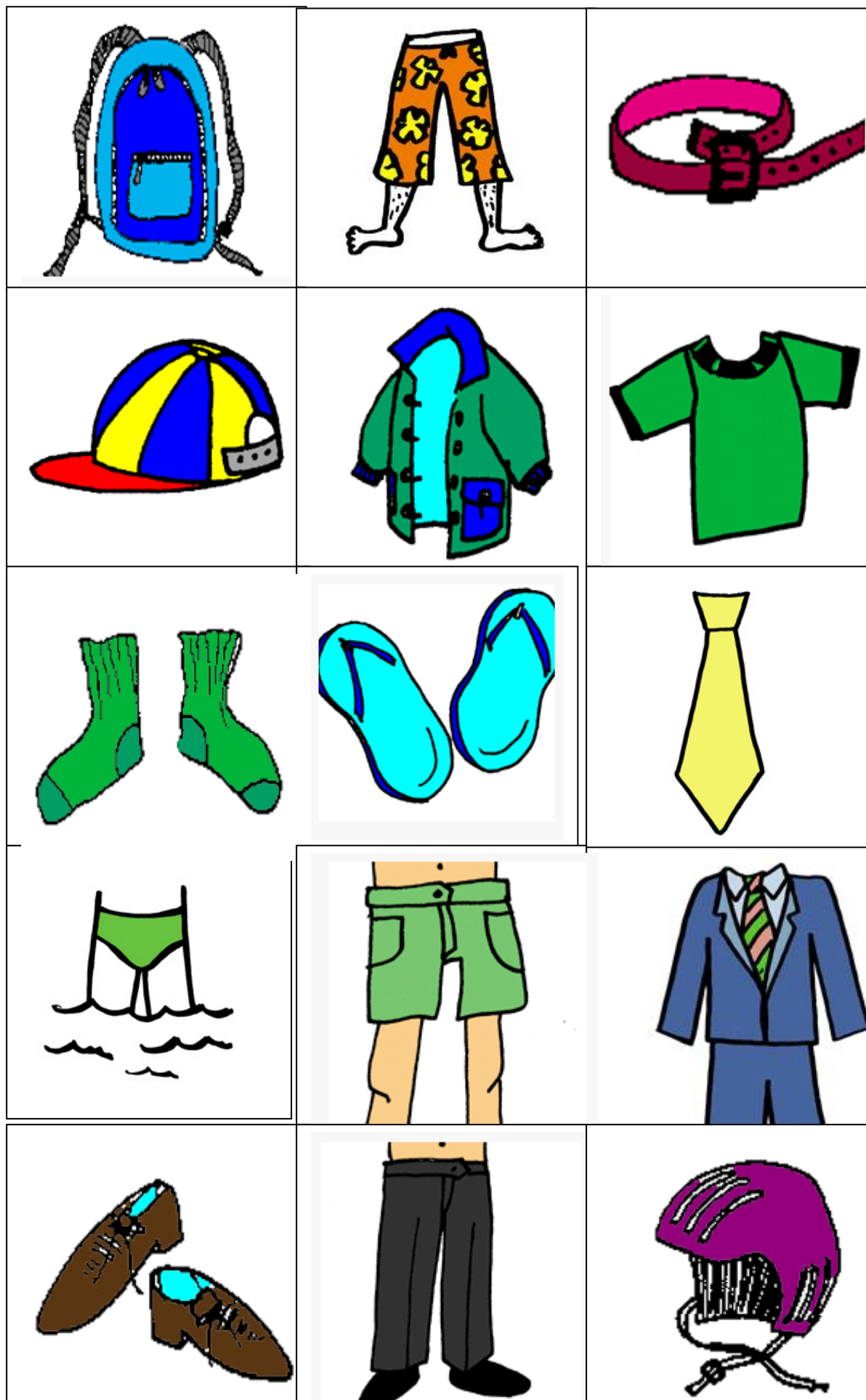
HINT: Familiarise the student with the boy and girl items before starting the game, this will ensure that the student is able to name each item.

- Each player places a playing a playing board in front of them (either the boy or girl board).
- Place the small boy/girl item cards face down in a pile in the middle
- Each player takes turns selecting a card from the top of the pile and then deciding if the item belongs to the girl or boy.
- The player must then make up a sentence about 'who' the item belongs to e.g., "It is **her** shoes" or "The shoes belong to **her**" etc
- If the player says the sentence correctly, and the item belongs to their board (eg the boy) they can then post the card in their wardrobe.
- If the item does not belong to their board, the player places the card at the bottom of the pile and the other player has their turn.
- Players continue in turn.
- The first player to pack all their wardrobe items is the winner!

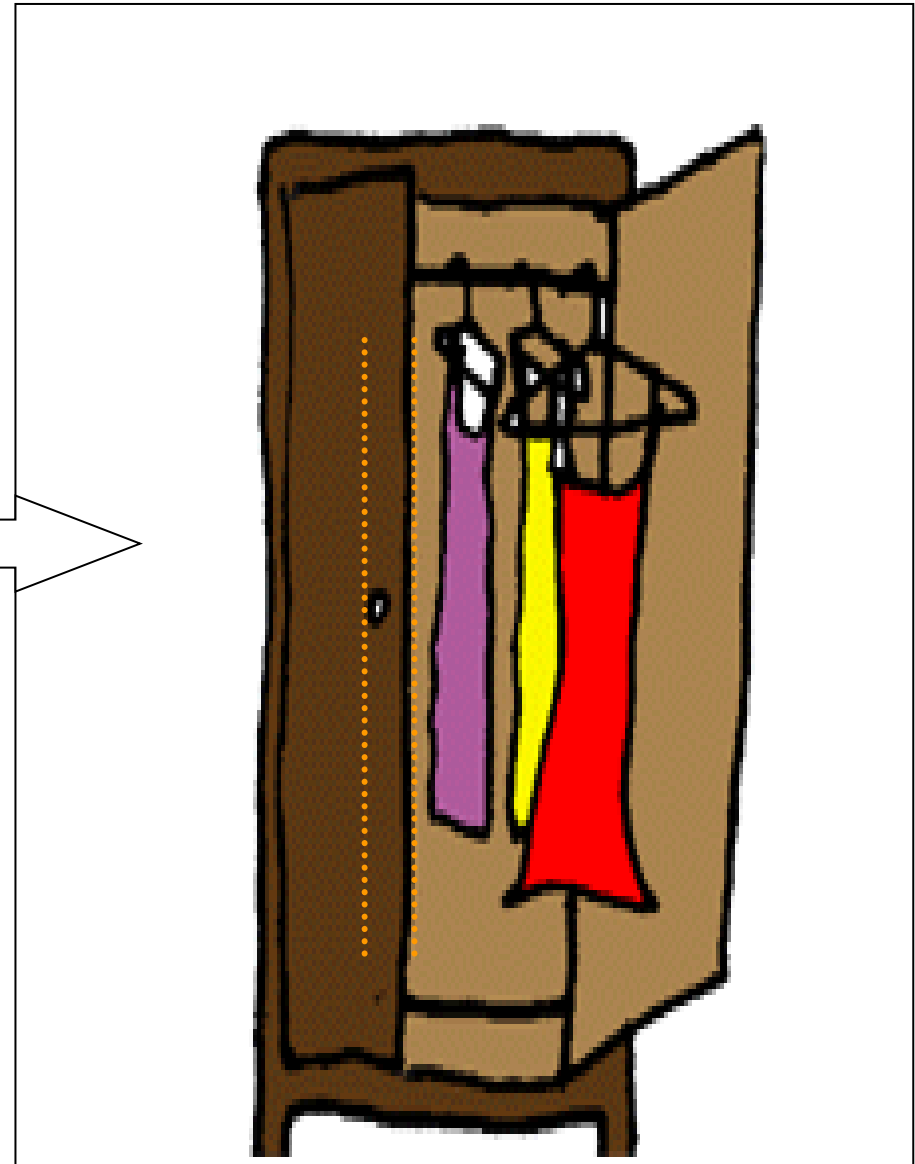
